

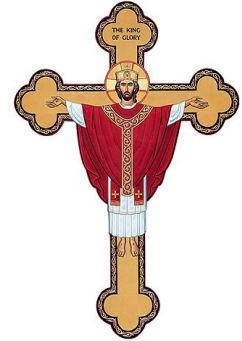

11. Share in the pouring out of God's mercy
12. Enter more deeply into the mystery of God's love and His plan of salvation
